



DAY	PROGRAM	
1	<p>Upon your arrival at OR Tambo International Airport, make your way to domestic departures for your flight to Cape Town International Airport.</p> <p>Arrive in the Mother City and depart on a private transfer to the hotel</p> <p>Arrive at your hotel and check in. Rest of the day at leisure</p> <p>Overnight: The SS Waterfront Hotel**** OR SIMILAR (Dinner)</p>	
2	<p>Breakfast will be served at the Hotel.</p> <p>Depart on a private Cape Town city Tour, Take the cable car to the top of Table Mountain (Table Mountain is weather permitting) for a panoramic view of the city and coastline. Continue through the historic Malay Quarter, past the South African Museum, with its famed Bushmen exhibits, the Castle and other interesting sights. Towards the end of the morning a visit is made at the Victoria and Alfred Waterfront. This is South Africa's most talked about tourist venue with many shops and restaurants. We now continue alongside the Indian Ocean, and stop to see the Jackass penguin colony, which has become well established, at Boulders beach near Simonstown. Then we travel onwards until we reach Cape Point and the Cape of Good Hope. Said to be the romantic meeting place of the two mighty oceans, the Atlantic and the Indian, Sir Francis Drake the Explorer once called it "the fairest Cape that we saw in the whole circumference of the Globe". And rightly so, it must be the highlight of any visit to the Mother City, if not South Africa. Our last stop of the day is at the Kirstenbosch</p>	

	<p>Botanical gardens, home of some 3 500 species of Southern African fauna and flora. Evening at leisure Included meals: Breakfast /lunch /dinner. Overnight: The SS Waterfront Hotel**** or similar</p>	
4	<p>Breakfast will be served at the Hotel. Depart on a private overland transfer to Knysna (+/- a 07 hour drive) Arrive and check into your Hotel. Rest of the day at leisure 17h00/1800 Depart on a John Benn sunset cruise. Included meals: Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner Overnight: The Knysna Log Inn**** or similar</p>	
6	<p>Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Private transfer from the hotel to George Airport for your flight to O.R. Depart on a private road transfer to Johannesburg via a 03 hour Gold Reef City Tour (Please Note: Gold Reef City is closed on Mondays & Tuesdays) Arrive at the hotel and check in. Rest of the day at leisure Included meals: Breakfast Overnight: The Peermont Mondior Hotel****</p>	
9	<p>Breakfast will be served at the hotel. Take the complimentary hotel shuttle to O.R. Tambo International Airport for your flight to Nairobi..!!! Met upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport. After customs and immigration formalities, our representative will meet and transfer to the Nairobi hotel for check in. Rest of the day will be spent at leisure. Included meals: Breakfast Overnight: Intercontinental Hotel or similar</p>	
10	<p>Breakfast at the hotel. After a short pre-safari briefing by your English speaking driver guide, drive to Lake Nakuru National Park for lunch at Lake Nakuru Lodge. In the afternoon set out for game viewing drive in the Park, home to not just the lesser flamingo but over 400 species of birds and one of the few places to see the endangered white rhino. Other wildlife at the park includes lions, leopards, zebra, gazelles, eland, giraffe and the hyrax. (approx. 215 km). Included meals:Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner Overnight: Lake Nakuru Lodge or similar</p>	

<p>11</p>	<p>Breakfast at the Lodge. Thereafter check-out and drive to the Masai Mara Game Reserve, one of the most exciting game reserves in Kenya. You will arrive at the Keekorok Lodge in time for lunch. A brief time after lunch to relax at your own leisure before heading out for a spectacular afternoon game drive, with a good chance of seeing all the members of the “Big Five”- the elephant, the lion, the rhino, the buffalo and the leopard. You will be back in the lodge in time to freshen up for dinner</p> <p>Included meals:Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner</p> <p>Overnight: Keekorok Lodge or similar</p>	
<p>12</p>	<p>Full day in the reserve with early morning, mid-morning and late afternoon game drive or full day with packed lunches.</p> <p>Masai Mara is a magnificent landscape of open plains bisected by the Mara River and its tributaries, and punctuated by marshes and forests. Certainly the most frequented game reserve in Kenya, this 650 sq kilometer reserve supports the highest density of game to be seen anywhere. During the seasonal migrations, Masai Mara is home to up to a million wildebeest and an equally impressive number of zebras that move into the area from neighboring Serengeti National Park, in Tanzania. The reserve is home to all the “big five” and it is also possible to observe; baboon, eland, ostrich, bat-eared fox, jackal and cheetah. The rivers abound with hippos and crocodiles.</p> <p>Included meals:Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner</p> <p>Overnight: Keekorok Lodge or similar</p>
